DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOW SITE:

From I-77, take I-26 West and follow the directions below. From I-20, take I-26 East and then follow the directions below. From the Columbia Metropolitan Airport, follow the exits out to Highway 302, turn right, and follow the directions below.

From I 26 (East or West) take Exit 113 and go towards South Congaree/Columbia Metropolitan Airport on Highway 302. Go approximately 4 miles, and turn left onto Ramblin Rd. At 0.1 miles, turn right on Oak St. The site is on the left.

TO THE CROSSROADS ANIMAL HOSPITAL FROM THE SHOW SITE:

Exit the show site to Oak St., turn right to go back to Ramblin Rd. Turn right onto Ramblin Rd., and go to the 4-way stop. Turn left onto Pine St. At the traffic light, go straight. At the 4-way stop, continue straight. At the next traffic light, continue straight - the road changes to Emanuel Church Rd. Continue on through another traffic light, and another 4-way stop. When Emanuel Church Rd. ends, take a left at the light and Crossroads Animal Hospital is on the right.

Attention Exhibitors

PARKING: Ample free car parking is available. *Reserved parking for committee and handicapped under covered area.*

The Show Site will be available to exhibitors after 3:00 pm on Thursday, September 22, 2022. Dogs must be removed from the Show Site immediately following Best of Breed judging Sunday, September 25, 2022.

Grooming in designated areas only! No gasoline or diesel generators permitted within 100 ft. of any ring in which the show is conducted.

No crates permitted ring side except crates on dollies, during judging only.

Dogs must be on leash except when crated or as required for judging.

All trophies must be claimed the day of the show. None will be mailed. Trophies not claimed will become the property of the show-giving club. The Club reserves the right to substitute a trophy of equal or greater value.

Owners are strongly advised to have all vaccinations current on their dogs. Many states require a proof of rabies certificate. Please bring with you all proof of vaccinations. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Exercise pens may be set up only in posted areas. There is plenty of green space available for properly exercising your dogs. The site will be available after 3 p.m. Thursday, September 22, 2022.

AKC Code of Sportsmanship

PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
